### **NEWTOWN RAIL TRAIL – UPPER SOUTHAMPTON TOWNSHIP**

- 2.5 miles from County Line Road to Bristol Road
- Connects to Pennypack Trail and Tamanend Park
- 12' Crushed Stone
- Design plus construction costs: \$3,100,000
- Montgomery County shared crossing costs
- Ribbon Cutting was held April 27, 2022







# **NEWTOWN RAIL TRAIL PHASE II UPDATE**

- The extension will be approximately 1.75 miles
  - 1.4 miles extending through the railbed from the current end point
  - 0.3 miles will run within the Nature Center, from the railbed to the front parking lot
- Key elements include the Bristol Road and Bustleton Pike crossings, Churchville Train Station Parklet, and boardwalk to cross wetlands
- This will be a County owned trail
- Funding
  - \$1,000,000 million IIJA
  - \$1,500,000 million State and Regional TASA funds
  - The county will cover the remaining costs







# **NEWTOWN RAIL TRAIL PHASE II – ESTIMATED TIMELINE**

- Final Conceptual Trail Alignment Spring 2023
- Obtain required clearances Spring 2023
- Develop Preliminary Opinion of Probable Construction Cost – May 2023
- Public Open House to present conceptual trail design May 2023
- Final permitting including, PennDOT Safety, Traffic, and ADA Review November 2023
- Final plans and probable cost developed June 2024
- Construction bidding Fall 2024
- Construction completion Fall 2025



### **UPPER BUCKS RAIL TRAIL**


- Completed in 2020
- Located in Richland and Springfield Townships
- Connects to Saucon Rail Trail in Lehigh County
- Connects to Veteran's Park
- First trail construction outside of a park
- 3.2 miles / 12' Crushed Stone
- 800 foot boardwalk
- Funding (Act 13 Marcellus Shale Funds)
  - Engineering \$78,400
  - Construction \$1,267,000
- County Operated Facility








#### **UPPER BUCKS RAIL TRAIL**





#### **NESHAMINY GREENWAY – NESHAMINY MANOR**



- 2.3 miles first phase 1.8 miles
- 10' wide asphalt path
- Provides access to County Facilities, Shopping, Residential and Offices
- Funding:
  - Engineering Act 13 \$414,300
  - Construction CMAQ \$2,100,000
- Construction late 2023







#### **NESHAMINY GREENWAY - DARK HOLLOW PARK**




- 0.5 mile Nature Trail
- Provides access to County
  Trailhead
- Small extension near BCWSA
- Design completed in December of 2022
- Funding for Design only:
- DVRPC Regional Trails Program Grant
- Pennsylvania DCNR Grant
- No funding in place for construction







### **NESHAMINY GREENWAY - CORE CREEK PARK**




- 0.9 miles
- 10' wide asphalt path
- Provides access to County Park and Residential
- Funding:
  - Design Act 13 \$261,200
  - Construction Transportation Alternatives Set-Aside - \$995,000
- Design to be complete in Summer of 2023
- Construction takes about 1 year



# LEVITTOWN TRAIL- LEVITTOWN/MILL CREEK PARKWAY



lanning Commission

- 1.1 mile pathway when finished
- 10' Pathway
- 0.9 miles of new pathway
- Combination of new trail, filling in gaps and street crossing improvements
- Funding:
  - Coastal Zone Management Grant \$70,000
  - County Funds \$71,000
- Design complete by end of 2024
- Pursuing construction funding from TASA





# LONGER TERM TRAIL PRIORITIES

#### **Trail Development:**

- Completion of Newtown Rail Trail to Newtown
- Completing the connection from Newtown to the Delaware and Lehigh Canal Trail
- Expansion of the Neshaminy Greenway Trail

#### **Potential Regional Trail Development:**

- PA Highlands Trails
- East Coast Greenway

#### Local Trail and Bicycle Planning:

- Continuing to assess trail and bicycling opportunities throughout the county
- Continued planning assistance to municipalities
